United States Flag

If you ever visit the nursery, you will see we fly the United States flag twenty-four seven. These flags usually need to be renewed every two years. The current flag is a memorial service flag for Lee Sheaffer. He enlisted in the United States Army at the age of 19. His rank was private and served from June 1917 to May 1919 in the Headquarter Company 112th Infantry Division of Pennsylvania. He fought in four major battles in France and Germany between July 14th and November 18, 1918. He left France on April 30th, 1919 to return to the United States and was discharged from Camp Dix, New Jersey on May 7th, 1919. I know Lee would appreciate the flag being flown at this club. He was a great trout fisherman that spent many days on the trout streams in Perry and Cumberland Counties.

The Club would like to start a policy to fly these flags that were awarded for service, valor or any other reason. These flags are usually stored and never used as a remembrance for what they were given. If anyone who wishes to donate a flag with a background, write a note explaining why the flag was given and to whom the flag honors. When the flag is flown at the club the article will be posted in our newsletter.
